We turn now to a new embarrassment for the secret service! 3 agents who were preparing for the president's arrival in Europe a little earlier this week have now been sent home after one of them was found drunk in a hotel! NBC's Peter Alexander's in Brussels. He is travelling with the president. Peter Good morning to you! Matt, good morning to you! What is another **black eye** for the secret service that's still under **scrutiny** for a separate scandal that **prostitution** scandal in Cartagena, Colombia just 2 years ago. This latest incident took place just one day before president Obama arrived here in Europe!

With president Obama this morning paying his respects to fallen soldiers from World War One at Belgium Flanders Field Cemetery, the agency assigned to protect the president. is dealing with another embarrassing **epicenter**. US secret service sources confirmed that one of its agency was found drunk and passed out in a hallway of the president's hotel in Amsterdam Sunday morning, barely 24 hours before president arrived for a week of intense international diplomacy! Hotel security contacted to the US embassy in the Netherland which **in turn**, alerted secret service managers, including the agency's new director Julia Pearson who is traveling with president Obama on this trip! In total, 3 employees were sent home Sunday for what a secret service spokesman called **disciplinary** reasons. The Washington Post reports all three were members of the secret service's elite counter assault team, known as CAT! The alleged misbehavior comes 2 years after another high profile secret service scandal where a dozen agents and officers in Cartagena, Colombia ahead of the president's arrival for a summit there brought prostitutes back to their hotel rooms after a night of heavy drinking! The president called the agent's behavior unacceptable! "We are representing the people of the US and when we travel to another country, I expect us to observe the **highest standards**, because we are not just representing ourselves." Afterward, the secret service announced a new **code of conduct** with tightened standards that, sources say, these agents violated!
