In the courtroom, Led Zeppelin’s lead singer Robert Plant said he didn’t remember Spirit and that he and guitarist Jimmy Page came up with the song while sitting by a campfire outside a remote cabin in Whales.

The founding member of Spirit Randy Wolf died in 1997. According to the **complaint**, one year before his death, he wrote “I’d say it was a **rip-off** and the guys made millions of bucks on it and never said thank you. Maybe someday their **conscience** will make them do something about it” “When they played all these early recordings of Stairway to Heaven, it really felt **otherworldly** and magical to be sitting there.
