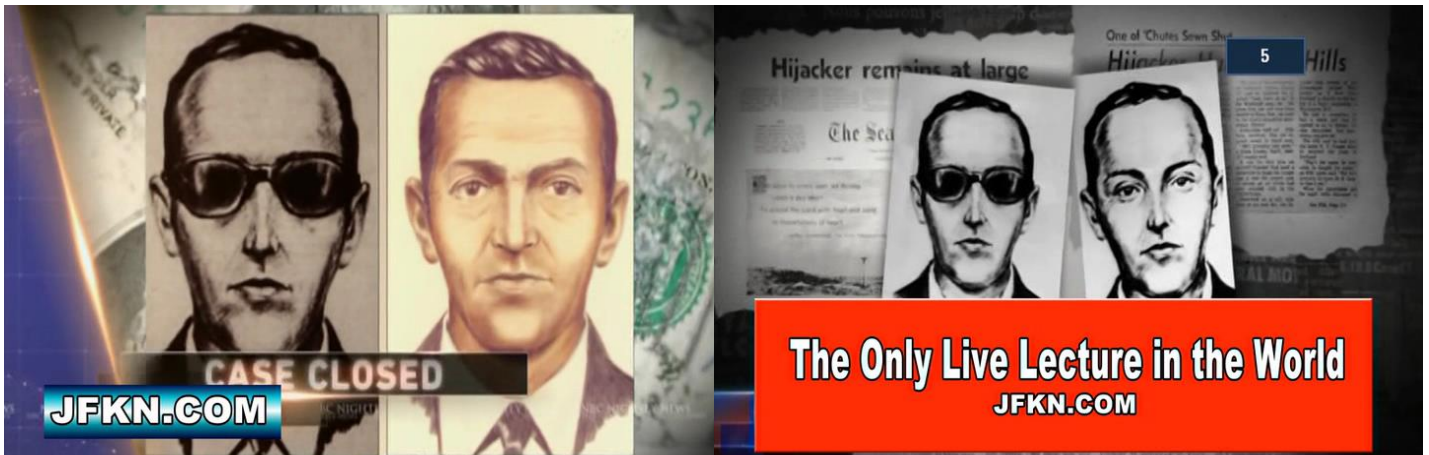

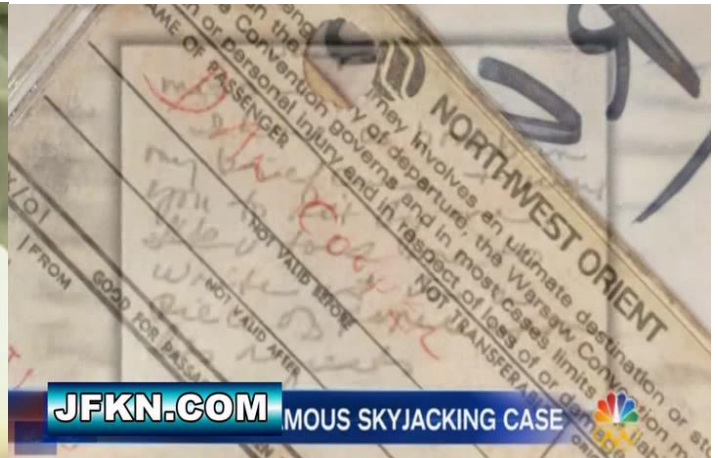
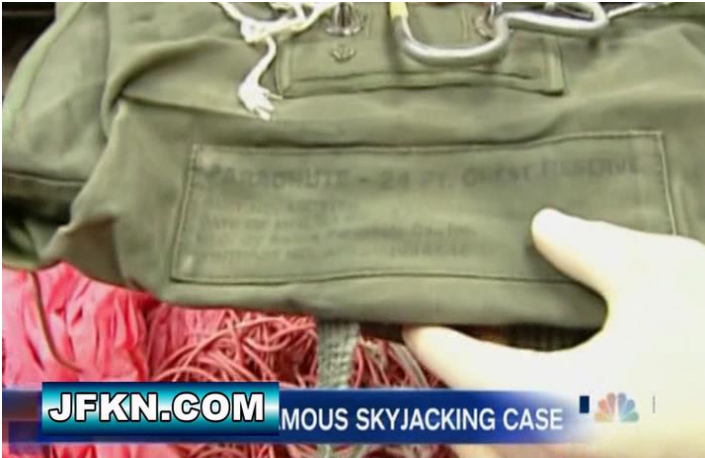
Finally it's one of the most **notorious** unsolved crimes in US history. The 1971 D.B. Cooper hijacking when a man jumped out of a plane with a parachute in a bag of **ransom** money and vanished. Now 45 years later, the FBI is closing the case because of a lack of credible leads. Our Cynthia McBeden has more on the mystery still baffling investigators.

45 years ago, D.B. Cooper **bailed out** of a 727 with \$ 200,000 strapped to his chest. It led to 100s of news reports. "He parachuted out of the plane. It landed in Reno and he hasn't been seen since" Inspiring a 1981 movie and dozens of **armchair detectives**. What the case has not had is a **resolution**. Despite the FBI's pursuing 1000s of leads and nearly as many suspects, the hijacker's true identity was never uncovered. And now he is not likely to be. The FBI officially ending what it called one of its longest and most **exhaustive** investigations.

It was a day before Thanks Giving in 1971. A man in a suit and tie identified himself as Den Cooper. He passed a note to a flight attendant claiming he had a bomb. The plane landed in Seattle where he exchanged the passengers for that \$ 200,000 and 4 parachutes. He then demanded to be flown to Mexico. 45 minutes later, the rear door opened and he jumped 10,000 feet into a **rainstorm**, hurling himself into history as the **perpetrator** of America's only unsolved hijacking. "He was not nervous, he seemed rather nice and other then, he wanted certain things to be done" Ralf Himelsbak was the FBI's **point man** on the case for years. "I think of him as being just another **sleazy rotten** criminal." But the one who got away. Synthia McBeden NBC news, New York.

Today the FBI said it is no longer hunting the mysterious hijacker known as D.B. Cooper. The leads have **dried up**. Back in 1971, he hijacked a Northwest Orient Airline 727, then over Washington State, he jumped out, wearing a business suit, a parachute and a bag with \$200.000. Some of the money was found, but he never was.
